# Map of Saskatchewan



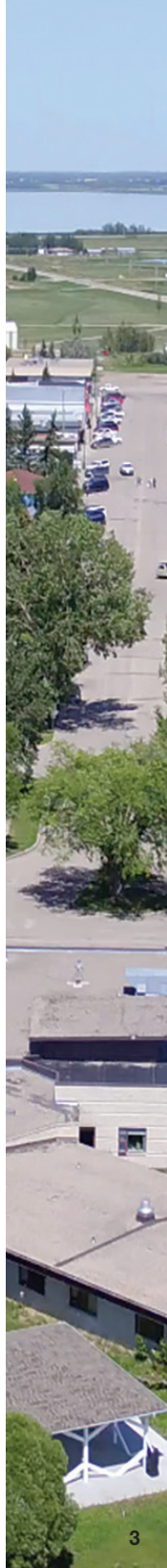


# Welcome

# Attractions

## Spiritwood Museum...

Carefully curated artifacts are displayed in period venues. Visit the farmhouse, agriculture shop and church for an enlightening trip back through the past of a prairie agriculture town. New to the venues is a trapper's cabin! Located just north of town on highway #24 or a short walk across the bridge at the Memorial Park along Railway Ave.

## Town Square...

The corner of Main and First has undergone a significant upgrade with a new park and bandshell. Plenty of benches offer a place to sit and enjoy your surroundings, with a fountain providing the gentle trickling of water that will lull you into small-town ease. Free music events throughout summer with a party on July 1st!

## Farmers Market...

Each Friday from May through October, you will find home baked goods, fresh vegetables, fruit, crafts and various other locally made specialties! Located along Main Street, you cannot miss the bright and beautiful signs. Open 8am - 1pm.

## Bull Riding...

The annual BRC (Bull Riders Canada) stop in Spiritwood takes place on October 11, 2025. The second-last stop before the finals, this is a popular event for the top cowboys as they try to gain points near the end of their run. Held indoors at the Rec Centre, this action-packed event sells out every year, with a Cowboy Cabaret featuring a live band following the bull riding.

A scenic lakeside golf course, Spiritwood Golf Club measures 5,865 yards from the back tees. This is a popular tourist course as it is situated on the historic Carlton Trail in the lakes district of Northwest Saskatchewan near the junction of Highways 3, 24 and 378. With the addition of 26 seasonal sites and five nightly sites, this is the greenest RV park in the province!





# Attractions

## **Rec Centre & Bowling Alley...**

Spiritwood boasts a multipurpose recreation facility that includes curling, bowling, as well as our hockey arena. With a finished mezzanine for sports enthusiasts' viewing pleasure or private functions, this beautiful Recreation Center is the activity hub of our town.

## **Campground...**

The Spiritwood Lions Campground offers 12 electric sites with water hookup. Picnic table and fire pit are standard at each site. Ideally located at the sports grounds, the campground is directly adjacent to the museum grounds. A short walk across the bridge takes you to the Memorial Park and the top of our beautiful Main Street. Sorry, no tenting sites available.

## **Cameron & Bourdages Memorial Park...**

Completed in 2017 to honour the memory of two RCMP constables that were killed in the line of duty while serving the community of Spiritwood, this stunning park provides a place to reflect and remember. With monuments to commemorate Cst. Robin Cameron and Cst. Marc Bourdages, this park also pays tribute to our own Cpl. Dustin Wasden and Cpl. Darby Morin – killed while serving in the Canadian Armed Forces.

## **Cross Country Ski Trail...**

On the north side of the old train tracks behind the wolf.

## **Community Garden...**

## Subway...

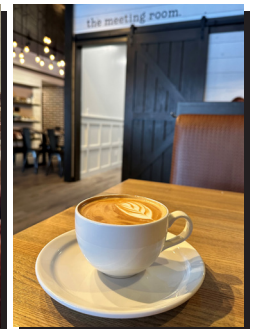
For your food on the go, stop in at the Spiritwood Esso & Subway.

# Regional Parks

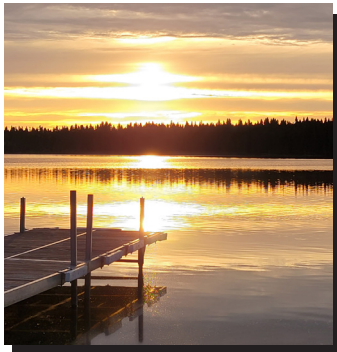
## Memorial Lake Regional Park...

Memorial Lake Regional Park is situated in the village of Shell Lake, SK, intermingled with the boreal forest and areas of sun-dappled poplars. Tree cover is varied with many sites located in dense pine trees and others sunlit with poplars sprinkled throughout the area.

## Meeting Lake Regional Park...

Meeting Lake Regional Park, located on the west end of picturesque Meeting Lake, has a blend of privately owned cabins, daily and seasonal campsites, and a rental cabin. They have something for everyone from fishing to boating; sunbathing to bird watching. The Round Hall (an 8-sided building), which is located in the center of the park, is ideal for family reunions, wedding receptions, anniversaries or other gatherings. It can host 200 people comfortably. It has a kitchen and bar facilities along with washrooms. It can be licensed to service up to 200 people. Located near the lakefront, the park's quaint non-denominational chapel is perfect for intimate weddings or small gatherings. It has seating for 100 people and can be heated. A donation of \$100 is encouraged for its use.

# Recreation

## Curling...

Join us in March for the annual Rocks, Ribs and Roars fundraiser – a fine dining evening out, complete with entertainment and fun.

## Minor Ball...

Spiritwood's Minor Ball club works hard to maintain the ball diamonds and the grounds at SAD SAAC (Spiritwood and District Sports and Agriculture Complex) Park. The club features four diamonds, a kitchen and modern washroom facility new in 2023.

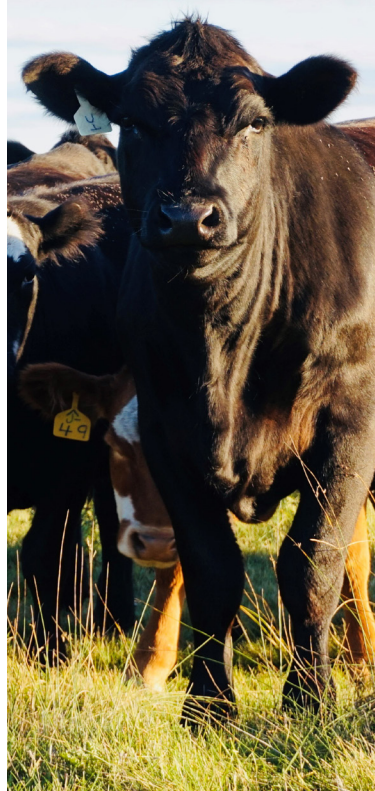

# History

The name "Spiritwood" was suggested by Rupert Dumond, the postmaster, who suggested this name as it was the town in North Dakota from which he had come. This name was accepted by the postal department. The first settlers were the LaFleurs – father and four sons – who settled north of the present highway on the east side of Witchekan Lake around 1910 or earlier. Old-timers can recall when hay was cut where now sit our many beautiful homes. They can also recall taking boat rides right where business places and homes sit (this would explain our ongoing challenge with water!)

- 1935...** The Village of Spiritwood was incorporated on October 1.
- 1943...** Cement sidewalks were to be laid down on Main Street; a cemetery was laid out. Chickens were not allowed to run loose. (No chickens after 1966.)
- 1959...** A request was made to the Department of Highways to have the highway rebuilt where it now passes through town.
- 1965...** Spiritwood became a town on Sept. 1, with a Mayor and five Councilors.
- 1976...** Request to National Housing for 12 Senior Citizen's housing units. New subdivision to get streetlights.
- 1985...** Spiritwood is home to the Silver Buckle Rodeo – one of the largest CCA-sanctioned amateur rodeos.
- 1999...** AA Midget Timberwolves become provincial champs!
- 2001...** Fast Pigs expands Spiritwood operations with open house to celebrate Tri-North Farms
- 2020...** Guy's Furniture moves out of its location on Main Street since 1953 in the former Strand Theatre to a new building at the corner of Highways #3 and #24.
- 2023...** Spiritwood Dental Clinic returns to Main Street
- 2025...** Spiritwood will Celebrate 90 Years

# History of the Wolf

“The wolf’s image for centuries was depicted in folklore and mythology as a shadowy, half-demonic beast and cunning predator. The wolf in our farming community of Spiritwood is a cunning predator and poses a threat for the surrounding cattle ranches. But still somehow the wolf has retained its symbol of vitality, spirit and wilderness. It is the wolf that portrays the spirit and vitality that the town of Spiritwood has to offer to our residents and our visitors.

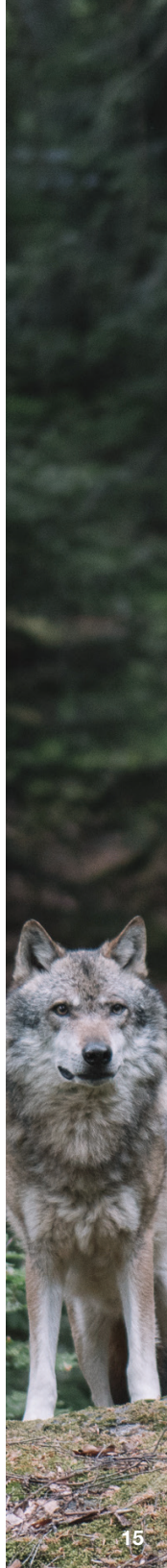
The profound similarities between human and wolf have been both apparent and important to our First Nations People. In some First Nations traditions, in the spirit world when wolves howl they are actually talking with the spirits, and if you ever have had the opportunity to listen to the wolves howl on a starlit night, it is a memory that will stay with you forever. The Spiritwood wolf is howling, is it talking with the spirits? Who’s to know!

The wolf in Spiritwood is seated on its hind legs and howling. So why is this significant? Wolves in the wild normally howl standing. It is only the Spiritwood wolf that sets itself apart from the rest of the pack by howling seated. This can simply be related to the town of Spiritwood that sets itself apart from the rest by being a unique and intriguing community.

The wolf sits dignified, high upon a beautiful white rock. Is there any symbolic feature with this? The white rock was moved into town from the Caffet farm, just west of Spiritwood, unknowingly holding some spiritualistic aspects pertaining to it as well. A First Nations elder claimed that the rock was a symbolic white buffalo rock, and that these are very rare. The white buffalo portrays the great creator and is a highly respected icon.

The wolf is made out of concrete, and stands about five feet high. It weighs about 1000 lbs and is a one-of-a-kind creation that was made specifically for the town of Spiritwood.
